




Allied Health Resources:

<p>DESCRIPTION: ABLEDATA is a catalog of over 29,000 assistive technology devices (with over 19,000 products currently available) from domestic and international manufacturers.</p> <p>Product descriptions include price and source company. Not all devices described are currently available for sale.</p>	<p>DESCRIPTION: CIRRIE is international in scope and collects bibliographic citations from all areas of rehabilitation. In addition to indexing from mainstream journals and internet sites, CIRRIE also includes citations to resources not readily available to U.S. researchers.</p> <p>Over 1400 journals are represented, and abstracts are available for most citations.</p>	<p>DESCRIPTION: REHABDATA is the leading literature database on disability and rehabilitation, 1997 - present. A separate backfile for 1956 - 1996 covers physical, mental and psychiatric disabilities, independent living, vocational rehabilitation, special education, assistive technology, law, employment and other issues as they relate to people with disabilities.</p>

- by type (or function) of product:

- using Boolean operators - AND, OR, NOT

- by subject headings. Subject thesaurus available at:

- by author
- by title keywords
- using limits for: Research Area, Geographic Area, Language, Year

Enter one or more terms onto search form; system assumes a Boolean AND relationship between terms

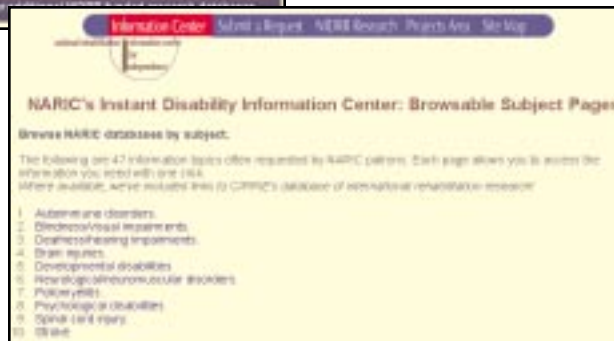

Search REHABDATA:

- by keyword
- using Boolean operators:
 & = AND
 / = OR
 ! = NOT
- by browsable subject pages
- using limits for time periods
- by limiting searches to Document Abstracts; Research Projects; or Organizations, Journals & Bookmarks
