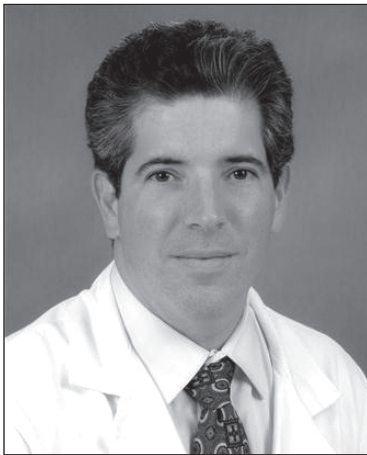

He has advanced training in echocardiography, nuclear cardiology, and cardiac computed tomography. Dr. Shipon is an instructor of Medicine at Thomas Jefferson University, and has published research in general cardiology, health policy, cardiac rehabilitation and cardiovascular imaging. Dr. Shipon is Co-founder of The Heart Center of Philadelphia.
