Endorsement as PA Early Intervention Coach

As we have reported in the past, Pennsylvania has adopted the Family-Guided Routines-Based Intervention (FGRBI) approach for infant toddler early intervention service delivery. All Pennsylvania providers are expected to complete required coursework, submit a video of a session in which they demonstrate FGRBI, reach fidelity with the approach, and be identified by OCDEL as an “endorsed coach.” [EITA’s webpage](#) includes information about the preparatory “Learning Path” that all providers must complete. These programs familiarize participants with the FGRBI approach and help them gain competence in using coaching strategies to support parents and caregivers to promote their infants’ and toddlers’ development.

The system tracks progress and allows access to subsequent courses only when earlier sections are complete. Learning Path modules earn credit toward annual self-choice requirements. Once the Learning Path is complete, providers enroll in either a Professional Learning Community (PLC) or Trio Group to master the skills needed for endorsement as a PA Early Intervention Coach.

Providers in Philadelphia Infant Toddler Early Intervention who have already completed the Learning Path should register for a Professional Learning Community: Coaching Across Settings or a Trio. For more information [Click here](#)
