

The 2024-2025 training year begins July 1.

Tips to consider:

- To get a copy of a TLC certificate, sign-in to your TLC transcript. Please note all eLearning certificates are posted towards the bottom of the TLC transcript.
- Check that vou completed everything for the training before contacting TLC about the status of your certificate. Go to the TLC registration page, to review what is expected to be completed.
- Contact TLC if you have more than one TLC account and want to merge the accounts. Never create a duplicate account.
- Update your TLC account if you changed agency, cell number and/or email address. To update your TLC account: you must sign-in to your TLC transcript, located on the upper right corner click on the hyperlink "Update contact information", and after all updates are completed click on "update account".
- To obtain the most recent certificate of completion from a refresher training, you must sign-in to your TLC transcript and click on the hyperlink "print certificate".
