ERCP Skills: An In-depth Review with Live Observation

ERCP Skills: An In-depth Review with Live Observation is part of an on-going series directed by the Pancreaticobiliary and Advanced Endoscopy Section of the Jefferson Division of Gastroenterology and Hepatology. The program is designed for *licensed* healthcare professionals that are practicing ERCP. Teams of physicians, nurses, and/or technicians are encouraged to apply to deepen team learning and communications.

This full-day "boutique" CME accredited course uniquely combines didactic material and live-case demonstrations to provide interested participants with a comprehensive small-group learning experience. Participants will have the opportunity to directly observe live cases and interact with the advanced endoscopy team performing the procedures. In this fashion, the nuances of performing ERCP, often lost in large scale live endoscopy courses, can be optimally conveyed and appreciated. The program will focus on ERCP techniques of particular relevance to the community gastroenterologist including cannulation techniques, sphincterotomy, stone extraction, lithotripsy, biliary and pancreatic stenting, ampullectomy, and cholangioscopy.
